NOVEMBER SHOW:

- Chapter House Lane presents André Piguet's 'C.M.B.Rrrr' on the occasion of its first birthday. Come to the show opening to celebrate this milestone with drinks between 6-8pm, Thursday 1 November.
- Piguet grew up with the surf of the Gold Coast a constant backdrop, perhaps incidentally shaping his
 interest in working with resin and perspex. Wax on, wax off, the way water beads around a surface –
 fluid, yet precise. And now, similar forms are mirrored in a distant, opposing sphere the vast outer
 regions of space.
- Piguet explores the big bang, researching the microwave radiation that represents our genesis and our future, posing boggling unanswered questions.
- An interest in history eventually drew him past the human, to 'deep time' where maths is the only avenue both analytical and abstract enough to bring sense to the mass. As for the mess, well, there's art. And Piguet's slow and painstaking interpretation of images caught by cameras infinitely more advanced than the human eye is a fabulous introduction.
