


CHAPTER HOUSE LANE

Chapter House Lane, in collaboration with Sugar Mountain Festival, invites you to an exhibition by Melbourne-based, Japanese artist, Chaco Kato.

A founding member of the Slow Art Collective and educated in fine arts in Tokyo, Boston and Melbourne, Chaco Kato's creative practice crosses genre and form, focussing on sustainability and eschewing gross consumerism. Best known for ephemeral, playful installations, Kato brings her sense of humour and signature string construction to Chapter House Lane.

In its second year, the annual Sugar Mountain Festival brings contemporary musicians and visual artists together to highlight the collaborative nature of the two art forms, and the way in which they each influence the others' creativity.
