Jonas Ropponen *Pubism*

15 January – 1 February

Jonas Ropponen's paintings throw fingernails, pubic hair, pulped magazines and pigment into arresting swirls of colour that are as personal as they are pretty.

Jonas Ropponen is literally all over his new series of paintings for Chapter House Lane. Hair, blood, semen, saliva and fingernail clippings feature in combination with splashes of pigment and pulped *Watchtower* magazines – a nod to his upbringing as a Jehovah's Witness. Sculpture meets painting meets personal history.

Born in Sweden and Melbourne-based, Ropponen explains that his textured abstract pieces are 'as much an investigation into colour, materials and processes, as they are repositories of my DNA'. The by-products of human life, instead of being thrown away, are here captured, layered and composed together into arresting swirls of colour.



Ropponen reveals both himself and his process by combining found materials with a bright palette of blue, yellow and red. The colours draw you in to look closer and provide an anchor point for navigating the paintings, revealing work that's both personal and abstract, grotesque and joyful, hectic and intuitive.

This exhibition will be accompanied by an artist talk, in which Ropponen will discuss the 'Pubism' series, his process and background. Check our website for details in the coming week.
