CONTINUE: THREE BRISBANE ARTISTS DESCEND ON CHAPTER HOUSE LANE IN JUNE

Chapter House Lane is delighted to take part in <u>Dispatch</u> a window-space art exchange program this June. The exhibition titled *Continue: Three Brisbane Artists* is curated by Kate McKenzie and will see works on display by Brisbane-based artists Archer Davies, Sarah Poulgrain and Angelica Roache-Wilson.

Continue: Three Brisbane Artists derives its name from the wisdom imparted by a favourite teacher of German artist Jonathan Meese: "Continue, continue, continue," in itself a reflection of the dedication that the art making process requires.

The works themselves respond to and articulate Brisbane, giving an insight into what it is like to live and make art there, and yet call upon influences from international artists and art history.

The exhibition will showcase oil paintings by Archer Davies, Angelica Roache-Wilson and a site-specific installation by Sarah Poulgrain.
